Performance note

To play the fixed electronics

A laptop with Ableton Live or free QLab software (there is currently no tablet/iPad version of QLab)
A MIDI USB foot controller (an electronic piano expression/sustain pedal **won't** work) and USB cable to connect it to the laptop
Stereo speakers and mixing desk
Audio interface and cables from laptop to mixing desk

For amplification (required)

A directional microphone
A microphone stand
An XLR cable connecting the microphone to the mixing desk
Speakers

Performance notes

Use Ableton in **Session View**.

Triangular play symbols: trigger tape with MIDI foot pedal.

Square stop symbol at end: stop tape with MIDI foot pedal or laptop spacebar.

Flute tone (*molto sul tasto*): bow over the fingerboard at a strong harmonic node. Use normal finger and bow pressure.
